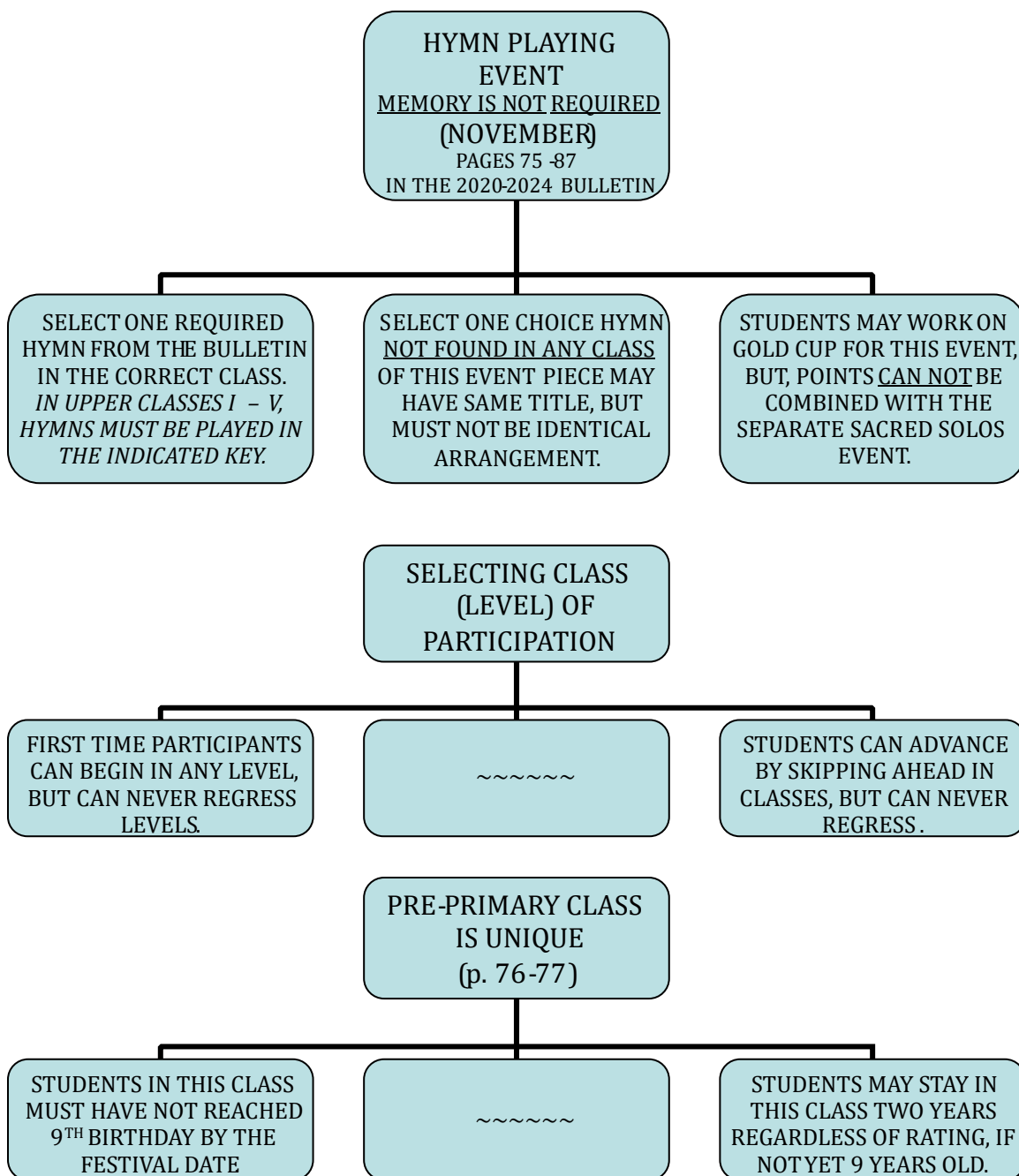

ON
PROGRESSION
OF
CLASSES (LEVELS)**

IN PRE-PRIM.-PRIMARY E.
STUDENTS RECEIVING A
SUPERIOR MUST ADVANCE TO
THE NEXT CLASS. STUDENTS
MAKING LESS THAN A
SUPERIOR MAY REPEAT THE
SAME CLASS (ONE TIME) WITH
DIFFERENT PIECES, OR
ADVANCE TO NEXT CLASS.

IN UPPER HYMNAL CLASSES
I - V (pp. 83-87)
STUDENTS MAY STAY IN THE
SAME LEVEL FOR TWO YEARS
REGARDLESS OF RATING.
THIS RULE IS CLARIFIED IN
THE UPDATES FOUND ON THE
LAST SECTION OF THIS
DOCUMENT.

IN ANY FESTIVAL EVENT,
STUDENTS MAY REPEAT THE
HIGHEST CLASS INDEFINITELY
WITH DIFFERENT PIECES
(CLASS V - p. 87)

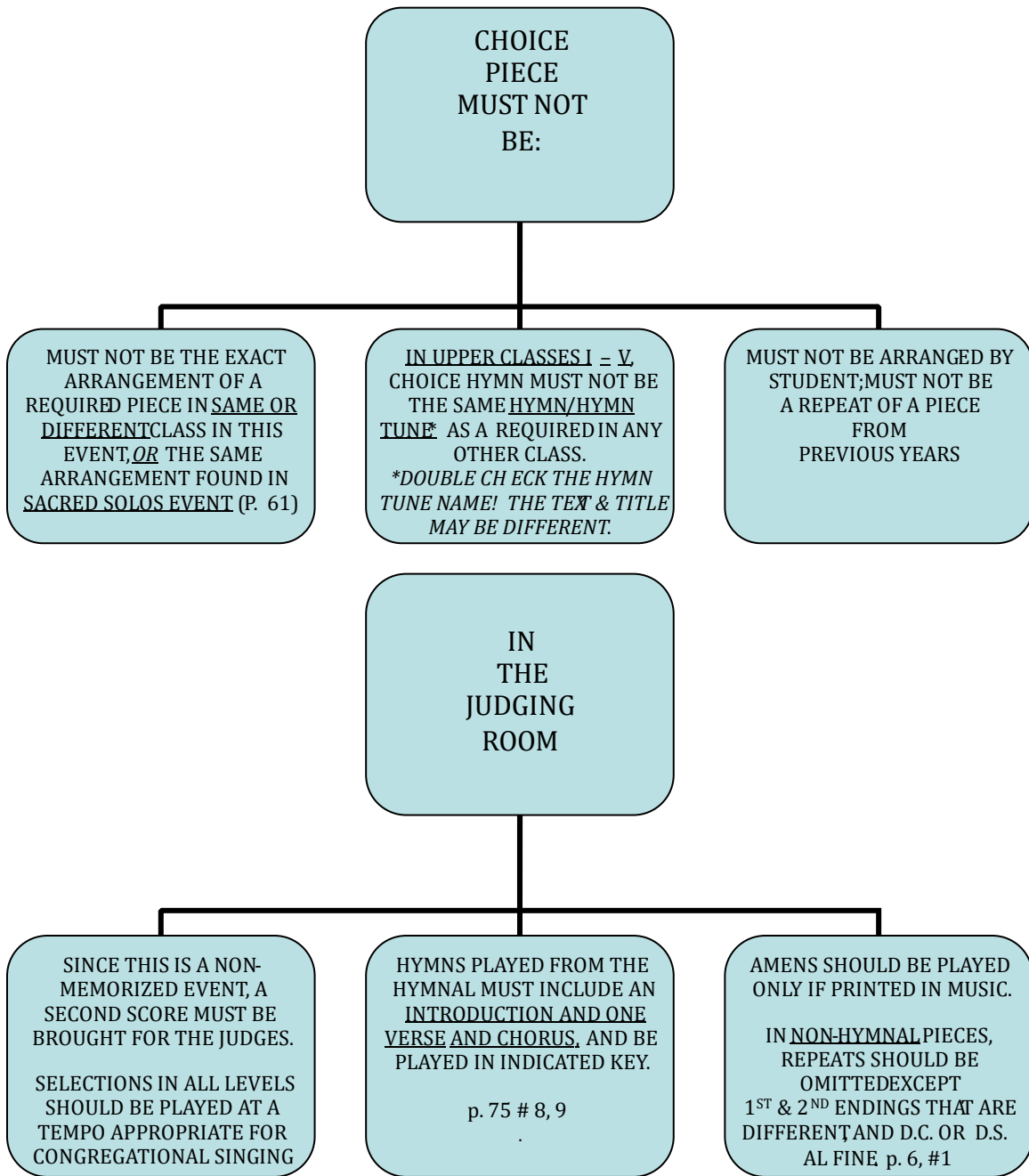

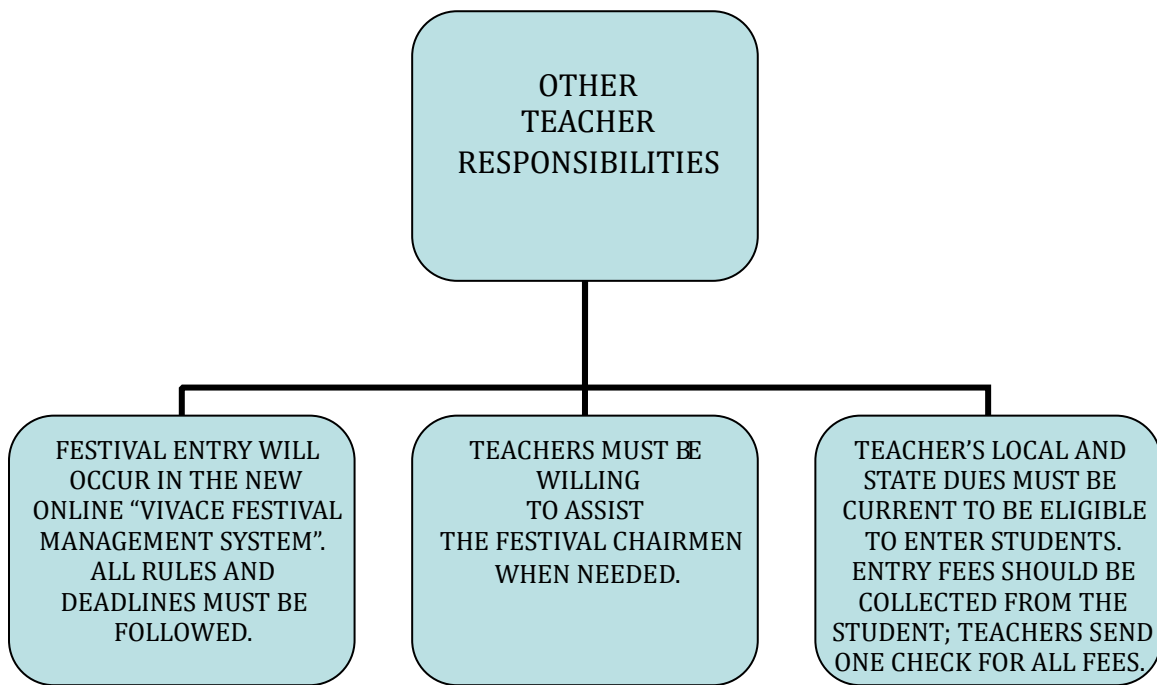
