**Please Give Careful Attention to the Following Policy for Organizations
with Multiple Teachers**

If the Federated Club listed above is an organization (i.e. a school) with more than one teacher who wishes to enter students in a junior festival, please observe the following procedure:

- Federate the Organization as a junior club; choosing one of the teachers to serve as the club's counselor and providing full information and payment as indicated above. The number of students listed should include the students of **all teachers participating**.
- All participating teachers, including the official club counselor listed above, must be members of a senior music club.
- All participating teachers, except the official counselor listed above, **will pay only the \$6.00 fee for Junior Keynotes**.

Junior Club Federation Fee - **New Deadline is Sept.1, 2023**

Note: "Junior" in the following items refers to students who have not reached their 19th birthday.

The deadline for the federation fee is Sept. 1st.

- A teacher (or counselor) desiring to federate his/her studio or club as a federated junior music club must first:
 1. Become an active member of the federated senior club by paying dues to that entity and by conforming to the established bylaws of that entity as pertains to junior clubs, **or**
 2. Become an NFMC Senior individual Member by paying the annual dues stipulated by the National Federation for senior individual membership (\$50.00).
- The annual minimum fee for federating a studio/junior club is \$33.00 which covers the first 16 junior students in the studio/club. All are eligible to participate in a junior festival. This fee covers:
 - one copy of each issue of Junior Keynotes Magazine - \$6.00
 - the Alabama Federation of Music Clubs - \$11.00
 - the National Federation of Music Clubs - \$16.00

Studios/clubs with more than 16 junior students pay the \$33.00 minimum fee plus \$1.55 per student for all in excess of the first 16.

- If a club/studio has **17** or more junior students, there are 2 options:
 - a. Option 1 - Pay the minimum of \$33.00 plus \$1.55 per junior student for all over 16. All are eligible to participate in a junior festival.
 - b. Option 2 - Pay the minimum of \$33.00 (which covers 16 festival entries) plus \$1.55 per additional junior student who wishes to enter a festival. This option was designed to give a break to teachers who have a larger studio, but have only a few over 16 who wish to participate in the festival.
 - c. If using Option 2 , the names of all students must be listed (use reverse side). Names of students who make a later decision to participate in a festival must be submitted (with \$1.55 per student) no later than one month before the festival.
- The junior federation fee is sent to the state treasurer who forwards the NFMC portion to the national treasurer along with the proper junior club membership report form.
